# 2. <u>SPECIFICATION FOR APPOINTMENT OF A SERVICE PROVIDER TO FORMULATE AND COMPILE THE CONCEPTUAL FRAMEWORK FOR THE DAIRY PRODUCTION WITHIN THE ENDUMENI MUNICIPAL AREA OF JURISDICTION.</u>

### 1. Introduction and Background

The UMzinyathi Development Agency seeks to appoint a competent and suitable service provider who will formulate and compile the conceptual framework for the Dairy Production within the Endumeni municipal area of jurisdiction. The UMzinyathi Development Agency in partnership with Orange Grove one of the largest dairy producers in the country together with Endumeni Municipality have agreed to establish the group of black emerging milk producers with the area. In this regard, Orange Grove has opened up a market of at least 15 000 liters of milk per day which must be sourced from the emerging sector. Again, the Endumeni Municipality has availed farm lands to be utilized towards this purpose. The Development Agency is playing a coordinating and facilitating role which should lead to the implementation of this agreement and realization of tangible results.

The Development Agency has resolved to revive the primary agricultural within the district thereby improve the food basket of the region, create sustainable sector and improve job absorptive capacity of the sector. Undoubtedly, this initiative proves to be a quick win for the sector and its dominant role players.

## 2. Objectives of the Assignment

- To create a platform for the emerging farmers to participate in locally thriving dairy production sector
- To improve localisation concept of milk production and participation of local farmers/producers to the main stream dairy economy
- c. To stimulate entrepreneurial ability and capacity of the local farmers within Endumeni
- d. To capitalise on the comparative advantage of Endumeni thereby make good use of locally based agriindustries

## 3. Scope of Work

- a. To formulate and compile in more detailed and professional manner the model adopted by the partners in this regard.
- b. To provide analysis of the milk supply and demand thereby find reasons to justify the implementation of the conceptual framework as envisaged by the partners.
- c. To provide analysis of the operational requirements of the dairy production. This means a detailed provision of what is required to get a far in a conducive state where it can be operationalised for milk production. The analysis

provided in this instance, should serve as a base for the business case and subsequently business plan should the business case prove viable.

- d. Develop a business case with clear financial implications for establishment purposes.
- e. Develop an operational model of the project in consultation with Orange Grove thereby ensure adherence to their normal standards and practice thereof.

The interested service providers may contact Mr S Mkhize for further clarity on the scope of work. However, a clear proposal is expected from suitable service providers that will spell out approach and methodology to execute the exercise. Furthermore, creativity and innovation will be credited accordingly if it's well displayed in the proposal. Again, the evaluation of proposals will also concentrate on previous experience that relates to assignments of this nature.

It is anticipated that the project should run for a period of 3-4 weeks after the date of appointment. The project milestones should be determined by agreement at project inception. Project Steering Committee would be established to monitor and advise on the progress of the project. A final close-out report would be expected from the service provider.
