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1. Introduction and Background

uMzinyathi Development Agency seeks to appoint a suitable and competent Service Provider to develop a comprehensive business plan for the resuscitation of the beef industry within the uMzinyathi region. The Agency seeks to realise this through the intensification of cattle farming and resuscitation of the local abattoir which has the capacity to slaughter 500 heads of cattle per day as well as a deboning and offal processing plant to complete the cycle of agricultural value add.

The uMzinyathi Development Agency is interested in resuscitating the beef industry as one of the core industries for meat supply thereby improve the food basket of the region, create sustainable industry and improve job absorptive capacity of the industry.

The UMzinyathi Development Agency has identified AFT, one of the largest cattle farmers in the region as a potential partner in this regard. AFT has agreed to localize the supply of cattle for subsequent supply to the local abattoir based in Glencoe. In this regard, AFT has opened up a market of at least a minimum of 250 head of cattle to be slaughtered per day at Glencoe Abattoir for sustainability of the abattoir. Therefore, the envisaged business plan should take

into consideration the intensification of primary production to supply the abattoir on a consistent basis as well as processing; full capacity operation of the abattoir and deboning plant which is currently operating at 25% of its capacity.

To this end, AFT has compiled an operational overview plan in this regard which is currently under review. The compilation of the comprehensive business plan seeks to guide the resuscitation process of the beef industry.

2. Objectives of the Assignment

The key objectives of the project are:

- a) Resuscitation of the beef industry
- b) Improvement of quality of beef within the cattle industry.
- c) Provide opportunities to local emerging and commercial farmers to participate in the value chain and add value from all parts of the cattle and from all types of beef raised.
- d) To address unemployment within the region and the country as a whole
- e) To provide an accredited training facility, on the aspect of primary production, for emerging farmers to develop both theoretical and practical knowledge.

Guided by the above overarching project objectives, the objective of the assignment is to develop a comprehensive and bankable business plan for the resuscitation of the beef industry which will guide the implementation of the project and influence the overall resuscitation and sustainability of the industry.

The assignment will include, but won't be limited to the following:

- Operational Planning
- Market Opportunities
- Sales Distribution
- Financial Projections

3. Scope of Work

The service provider is therefore expected to provide the following services in relation to the compilation of the business plans:

- Market research and opportunities
- Distributing channels
- Niche market opportunities
- Detailed market-based production plan, infrastructure and resources required.
- Project Plan

- Financial projections and Financial
- Statements.
- Organogram/ business structure (Governance structure, Management and Skills required)
- Long-Term Company Goals
- Growth Strategy

However, a clear proposal is expected from suitable service providers that will outline the approach and methodology to execute the exercise. Furthermore, creativity and innovation will be credited accordingly if it's well displayed in the proposal. Again, the evaluation of proposals will also concentrate on previous experience that relates to assignments of this nature.

4. Anticipated Timeframes

It is anticipated that the project should run for a period of 4 weeks after the date of appointment. The project milestones should be determined by agreement at project inception. Report backs should be directly to the PSC. A final close-out report would be expected from the service provider.

The service provider appointed to undertake this project should demonstrate the following key competencies:

- 2.4 "bid" means a written offer in a prescribed or stipulated form in response to an invitation by an organ of state for the provision of services, works or goods, through price quotations, advertised competitive bidding processes or proposals;
- 2.5 **"Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act"** means the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act No. 53 of 2003);
- 2.6 "comparative price" means the price after the factors of a non-firm price and all unconditional discounts that can be utilized have been taken into consideration;
- 2.7 "consortium or joint venture" means an association of persons for the purpose of combining their expertise, property, capital, efforts, skill and knowledge in an activity for the execution of a contract;
- 2.8 "contract" means the agreement that results from the acceptance of a bid by an organ of state;

- 2.9 "EME" means any enterprise with an annual total revenue of R5 million or less.
- 2.10 **"Firm price"** means the price that is only subject to adjustments in accordance with the actual increase or decrease resulting from the change, imposition, or abolition of customs or excise duty and any other duty, levy, or tax, which, in terms of the law or regulation, is binding on the contractor and demonstrably has an influence on the price of any supplies, or the rendering costs of any service, for the execution of the contract;
- 2.11 "functionality" means the measurement according to predetermined norms, as set out in the bid documents, of a service or commodity that is designed to be practical and useful, working or operating, taking into account, among other factors, the quality, reliability, viability and durability of a service and the technical capacity and ability of a bidder;
- 2.12 "non-firm prices" means all prices other than "firm" prices;
- 2.13 "person" includes a juristic person;
- 2.14 "rand value" means the total estimated value of a contract in South African currency, calculated at the time of bid invitations, and includes all applicable taxes and excise duties:

- 3.3 Points scored must be rounded off to the nearest 2 decimal places.
- 3.4 In the event that two or more bids have scored equal total points, the successful bid must be the one scoring the highest number of preference points for B-BBEE.
- 3.5 However, when functionality is part of the evaluation process and two or more bids have scored equal points including equal preference points for B-BBEE, the successful bid must be the one scoring the highest score for functionality.
 - 3.6 Should two or more bids be equal in all respects, the award shall be decided by the drawing of lots.

4. POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE

4.1 THE 80/20 OR 90/10 PREFERENCE POINT SYSTEMS

A maximum of 80 or 90 points is allocated for price on the following basis:

80/20

$$Ps = 80\left(1 - \frac{Pt - P\min}{P\min}\right)$$
 or $Ps = 90\left(1 - \frac{Pt - P\min}{P\min}\right)$

or

90/10

Where

Ps = Points scored for comparative price of bid under consideration

Pt = Comparative price of bid under consideration

Pmin = Comparative price of lowest acceptable bid

5.1 In terms of Regulation 5 (2) and 6 (2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, preference points must be awarded to a bidder for attaining the B-BBEE status level of contribution in accordance with the table below:

- 5.2 Bidders who qualify as EMEs in terms of the B-BBEE Act must submit a certificate issued by an Accounting Officer as contemplated in the CCA or a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS or a Registered Auditor. Registered auditors do not need to meet the prerequisite for IRBA's approval for the purpose of conducting verification and issuing EMEs with B-BBEE Status Level Certificates.

- 5.6 Tertiary institutions and public entities will be required to submit their B-BBEE status level certificates in terms of the specialized scorecard contained in the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice.
- 5.7 A person will not be awarded points for B-BBEE status level if it is indicated in the bid documents that such a bidder intends sub-contracting more than 25% of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not qualify for at least the points that such a bidder qualifies for, unless the intended sub-contractor is an EME that has the capability and ability to execute the sub-contract.
- 5.8 A person awarded a contract may not sub-contract more than 25% of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not have an equal or higher B-BBEE status level than the person concerned, unless the contract is sub-contracted to an EME that has the

capability and ability to execute the sub-contract.
